



In previous years Wild&Slow, has provided WorkShops for our traditional Irish Wild Salmon Fishermen. Wild&Slow2014 has decided to devote entirely this year's WorkShop Area 1 to Ireland's Wild Salmon Fisheries and to showcase the local economic benefits to just one very small village in Ireland called Inistioge in Kilkenny.

In WorkShop Area 1:

- Mick Murphy and Jimmy Murphy are licensed to fish Wild Irish Salmon out of Inistioge, Co Kilkenny. Over the two days, they will be present to build a traditional River Cot Canoe as used by countless generations beforehand on the River Nore to catch Wild Salmon.
- Mick Murphy will also take time out for two Work Shops (times below) on both days to explain how this traditional form of fishing has been passed down through the generations.
